


# CIRCULAR ARRANGEMENTS





• *Visualize the Circle:* Imagine a circle and mentally place the objects you're given around it.







- Identify Key Information: Pay close attention to the information provided about the arrangement. This might include:
- 1. Relative Positions: "X is to the left of Y" or "Y is opposite Z"
- 2. Direction: "Everyone is facing inwards" or "They are seated alternately"
- 3. Distance: "W is two places to the right of V"





- <u>Start with Fixed Points</u>: Look for clues that establish a starting point or fixed positions. These might be:
- 1. Opposites: People/objects directly opposite each other.
- 2. Adjacent Pairs: People/objects sitting right next to each other.





- *Fill the Gaps Logically:* Once you have some fixed points, use the remaining clues to fill the remaining positions in the circle logically. Consider:
- 1. Direction: If someone is "left of X" and X is fixed, where can they be placed?
- 2. Distance: If someone is "two places to the right," count the spaces from the fixed point.
