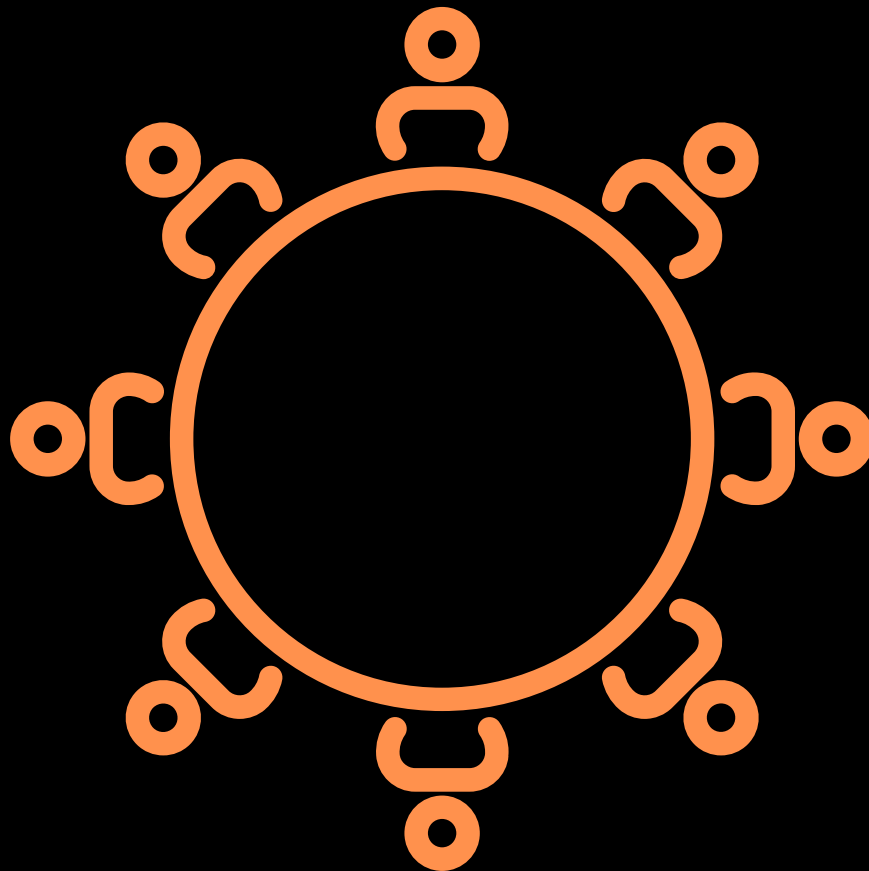

# CIRCULAR ARRANGEMENTS

## At a Glance

- *Visualize the Circle*: Imagine a circle and mentally place the objects you're given around it.





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## At a Glance

- **Identify Key Information:** Pay close attention to the information provided about the arrangement. This might include:
  1. Relative Positions: "X is to the left of Y" or "Y is opposite Z"
  2. Direction: "Everyone is facing inwards" or "They are seated alternately"
  3. Distance: "W is two places to the right of V"





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## At a Glance

- *Start with Fixed Points:* Look for clues that establish a starting point or fixed positions. These might be:
  1. **Opposites:** People/objects directly opposite each other.
  2. **Adjacent Pairs:** People/objects sitting right next to each other.





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## At a Glance

- *Fill the Gaps Logically*: Once you have some fixed points, use the remaining clues to fill the remaining positions in the circle logically.  
Consider:
  1. Direction: If someone is "left of X" and X is fixed, where can they be placed?
  2. Distance: If someone is "two places to the right," count the spaces from the fixed point.
